GSL is looking for on-call, temporary individuals during the school year who are available to work when school district employees are absent. A high school diploma and background check are required for all GSL employees.

- ◆ Substitute Teachers: Must be a licensed teacher in Minnesota
- ◆ Limited Short Call Substitute Teachers: A two-year short call substitute teaching license allows for teaching on a day-to-day basis, not to exceed 15 consecutive days replacing the same teacher or in the same assignment. These licenses are granted to those who hold a bachelor's degree and provide a signature from one or more Minnesota public school districts who wish to hire them in this capacity. The license is valid for functioning as a short call substitute teacher at all grade levels in all teaching fields. - ◆ Substitute Paraprofessionals: Will work under the supervision of a teacher
